Synopsis:

On the 23rd of February 24, 2025, at approximately 2312 hours, Deputy B. Goynes Unit #K25 San Jacinto County Sheriff's Office, Officer A. Vela Unit 609 Onalaska Police Department, and I Deputy L. Thomas Unit #13 San Jacinto County Sheriff's Office were dispatched to a call for service in reference to physical disturbance in progress.

San Jacinto County Dispatch advised the complainant Demonya Livingston (B/F DOB 03/04/1995) stated that her husband identified as Jarmar Brooks (B/M DOB 09/14/1990) was physically assaulting her in her home and requested assistance. Demonya was able to get out of the house and make it to her car with her three children; Javarre Brooks (B/M DOB 12/04/2013) age 11, Jarmaraion Brooks (B/M DOB 08/19/2015) age 9, and Jazzlynn Brooks (B/F DOB 06/15/2017) age 7.

Jarmar followed Demonya out of the house and to her car and started to beat on the windows attempting to continue the assault. Demonya stated to 911 that she needed EMS and Jarmar was trying to kill her.

Scene Summary:

The scene was found to be located at 60 Highway 980 North, Point Blank, San Jacinto County, Texas 77364. The white in color trailer house is located on the east side of Highway 980 North with a dirt and gravel drive way running west to east. At the end of the drive way positioned adjacent to the trailer is a metal two car carport on the north side of the trailer house. On the north side of the driveway is wood framed structure single family home white in color.

Narrative:

On the 23rd of February 24, 2025, at approximately 2312 hours, Deputy B. Goynes Unit #K25 San Jacinto County Sheriff's Office, Officer A. Vela Unit 609 Onalaska Police Department, and I Deputy L. Thomas Unit #13 San Jacinto County Sheriff's Office were dispatched to a call for service in reference to physical disturbance in progress.

San Jacinto County Dispatch advised the complainant Demonya Livingston (B/F DOB 03/04/1995) stated that her husband identified as Jarmar Brooks (B/M DOB 09/14/1990) was physically assaulting her in her home and requested assistance. Several calls came into San Jacinto County 911 Dispatch regarding the assault in progress. Demonya's oldest son Javarre Brooks (B/M 12/04/2013), age 11 notified dispatch that his father was hitting his mother. Dispatch advised Demonya was able to get out of the house and make it to her car with her three children. Jarmar followed Demonya out of the house and to her car and was beating on the windows attempting to continue the assault. Demonya stated to 911 that she needed EMS due to her bleeding and Jarmar was trying to kill her. The dispatch notified the responding deputies and officer, Jarmar, was in a truck ramming the vehicle Demonya and her three children Javarre age 11, Jarmaraion Brooks (B/M DOB

08/19/2015) age 9, and Jazzlynn Brooks (B/F DOB 06/15/2017) age 7 were in. Dispatch notified Onalaska Police Department of the incident and requested assistance.

Officer A. Vela Unit #609 Onalaska Police Department was first on scene. Officer A. Vela made contact with Jarmar attempting to get him into custody. Jarmar was not complying with Officer Vela. When I Deputy L. Thomas Unit #13 San Jacinto County Sheriff's Office arrived on scene, I observed Officer Vela on the ground along with John Brooks (B/M DOB 06/17/1954) Jarmar's father attempting to subdue Jarmar. Jarmar was actively resisting arrest by pulling his arms to his chest and refusing to comply with instructions. I started to help Vela pull Jarmar's left arm to the small of his back where we could restrain him in hand restraints. Once Vela and I were able to get Jarmar's left arm cuffed we both started working on pulling his right arm around. Jarmar was resisting by attempting to pull his arm back underneath himself. I was able to trap his arm and stop him from pulling his arm away. I pulled a second pair of cuffs out from my duty belt and was able to get the cuff on his wrist. Officer Vela was able to attach the two cuffs to one another while I maintained body control and keeping his arms pulled to the small of Jamar's back. Jamar was taken into custody and placed on an EMS gurney for transport to Livingston Hospital for treatment of injuries from the altercation with his wife and father. Deputy B. Goynes Unit #K25 San Jacinto County Sheriff's Office assisted EMS with getting Jarmar into the ambulance due to mud in the area. Once Jarmar was restrained in the ambulance, Deputy Goynes retrieved his camera and took photographic evidence of the scene. I checked on Demonya who was still in the car asking for EMS. I informed Demonya that EMS was in route. The ambulance we had staged was needed for Jarmar due to his condition and injuries. It appeared that Jarmar had taken some form of substance due to his erratic behavior and statements to his mother Linda Brooks (B/F DOB 04/17/1956) on scene stated to her "I'm high mom". A second EMS unit was dispatched to the scene for Demonya. After I evaluated Demonya's injuries and determined that no immediate first aid could be applied, I started to interview the witnesses on scene. Jarmar was transported to Livingston Hospital with Sergeant E. Chimmney Unit #30 San Jacinto County Sheriff's Office following due to Jarmar being in custody.

I interviewed Jarmar's father John who is 70 years old, stated his grandson had called him for help due to his father attacking and beating his mother. When John arrived, he came into the house to see Jarmar on top of Demonya actively choking her with both hands around her neck. John attempted several times to get Jarmar to stop. John grabbed a walking stick and started to strike Jarmar in an attempt to get him to let go of Demonya. Jarmar turned his attention to John and began to assault him. Jarmar pushed John into the table causing pain and started to strike him. John used the walking stick to strike Jarmar again. John told Demonya to run and get into her car with the kids. John thought Demonya had her keys and would be able to leave the scene. When Demonya exited the house, Jarmar attempted to follow when John

stepped in front of him, and they both fell out the front door of the elevated trailer house. Jarmar followed Demonya to the car and was attempting to get into the car. John once again used the walking stick to get Jarmar to stop. Jarmar then without effective consent from John, he took John's truck and started to ram the white Kia Sportage that Demonya and the three children were in. Jarmar struck the Kia several times pushing the vehicle sideways inside the carport area causing significant damage to the car and injuring one of the children inside the vehicle. John further stated that when Jarmar was attempting to turn the truck with significant damage around, the truck became stuck in the mud unable to move. While attempting to get the truck unstuck from the mud, Jarmar caused damage to the house, carport, and power pole. The Dodge Ram truck and Kia Sportage vehicles were unable to be moved after the incident.

I interviewed Demonya after EMS evaluated her for her injuries. Demonya stated that while she was packing her and the children's belongings, Jarmar started to assault her causing serious bodily injury to her. Jarmar picked up a knife and threatened to kill her with the knife. Their 11-year-old son was able to get the knife from his father and throw it out the door of the house. Jarmar continued to assault her and knocked her to the ground. While she was on the ground Jarmar started to choke her, making it difficult for her to breathe. While he was choking her, Jarmar was telling her he was going to kill her. She was able to make it out of the house with her children and get into her car the white Kia. Jarmar started to beat on the windows of the car again stating he was going to kill her. Demonya further stated that Jarmar was using a truck to ram her car while she and the three children were inside. Demonya and her daughter were transported to Kingwood Hospital for evaluation and treatment of their injuries. Kingwood Hospital advised that Demonya sustained multiple broken bones in her face, fractures, and significant bruising around her neck. Her daughter was treated for a large hematoma to her forehead she sustained from the impact of the truck striking the car Demonya and the children were in.

Officer Vela stated that when he arrived on scene and made contact with Jarmar, he was not following commands. Jarmar at one point, without the effective consent of Officer Vela, was able to gain access to the driver's seat of the Onalaska Police Department's patrol vehicle and attempted to flee the scene. The patrol vehicle was stuck in the mud and was unable to move. Officer Vela deployed OC spray to the face of Jarmar to get him out of the patrol vehicle's driver's seat.

Officer Vela will be creating a report that I will attach to this report about the actions prior to my arrival to the scene. Photographic evidence from the scene was uploaded to the report along with 911 calls from Higher Ground. I will also include a copy of the use of force form, strangulation form, body camera request form, and family violence form.


